Intel Capital Portfolio Company Gudeng Precision Goes Public In Taiwan

TAIPEI, Taiwan, Aug. 31, 2011 – Taiwan’s Gudeng Precision Industrial Co. Ltd. went public on the Taiwan’s GreTai Securities Market on Wednesday, becoming the third Intel Capital portfolio company to hold an initial public offering (IPO) this year.

“We congratulate Gudeng Precision on the successful completion of their initial public offering. Their commitment to innovation in wafer-handling technology will help semiconductor makers to produce the chips that power a new generation of computers and mobile phones,” said Keith Larson, vice president of Intel Capital.

The IPO is an important milestone for Gudeng Precision, which grew from a precision plastic-machining company to become a cutting-edge supplier of wafer-handling equipment. Intel Capital invested in the company in 2009.

The investment also gave us access to the resources we needed to strengthen our wafer-handling technologies,” said Bill Chiu, chairman and CEO of Gudeng Precision.

Gudeng Precision’s IPO marks another successful exit for Intel Capital’s Taiwan team, and highlights the central role that Taiwanese companies play in the global supply chain for computers, tablets and mobile phones.
