

## aGuide to Create a Windows 7\* UEFI Installer

## **Materials Needed:**

- Rufus (<a href="https://rufus.akeo.ie/">https://rufus.akeo.ie/</a>)
- Windows 7\* ISO
- Intel® Windows 7 USB 3.0 Creator Utility
   (https://downloadcenter.intel.com/download/25476/Windows-7-USB-3-0-Creator-Utility)
- USB Flash Drive
- Computer running Windows 8.1 or above
- 1. Download and install Rufus onto the same computer that contains the Windows 7 image.
- 2. Plug the USB flash drive into the computer where Rufus was installed.
- 3. Launch Rufus and select **YES** on the User Account Control dialog box.
- 4. Select the CD/HDD icon and select the Windows 7 ISO, then select **Open** to load the image.



5. To ensure that the USB flash drive is UEFI bootable, change **Partition scheme and target system type** to **GPT partition scheme for UEFI**.



6. Click **Start**, then **OK** to write the Windows 7 image to the USB flash drive.

**NOTE:** As the warning says, **Everything** on the flash drive will be erased.
