

## **INTEL ONE YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY**

If you have a problem with your Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board, you should approach whomever you bought it from (who is called the "Seller," and who has the primary responsibility to you).

However, subject to the following terms and conditions and in compliance with local law and regulation, you may also be entitled to the following Limited Warranty from Intel in addition to your rights against the Seller. **This Intel One Year Limited Warranty:**

- is a voluntary manufacturer's warranty from Intel. It lasts for one year from the original date of ***purchase*** of a new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board when that Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board was purchased in its original sealed packaging (and is what we mean when we use the words a "new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board");
- applies in only those countries in to which Intel has authorized its sale;
- gives you extra rights which are separate and in addition to (and not instead of) your rights against the Seller;
- gives you extra rights which are separate and in addition to (and not instead of) your rights under consumer and consumer protection law.

**What does this Intel One Year Limited Warranty cover?** Intel warrants two things. First, we warrant that the new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board, as delivered, if properly used and installed, will conform to Intel's specifications (which can be found at [www.intel.com/support/go/Galileo](http://www.intel.com/support/go/Galileo)) and will be free from manufacturing and material defects that affect performance against the specifications for 1 year from the original date of purchase of the new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board. Second, for 1 year from the original date of ***purchase*** of the new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board, we warrant that the new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board itself complies with product regulatory requirements (for example, CE markings in Europe) for those countries in which Intel® Galileo Gen 2 is authorized for sale. Intel makes no other promises or warranties about the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board.

**What *is not covered* by this Intel One Year Limited Warranty?** The following are excluded from the warranties above:

- Normal wear and tear and cosmetic damage. This means things like scratches, dents and broken plastic on ports, that don't result from a default of the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board, although it can be other things too;
- Damage caused by use of the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board with another product;
- Damage from or to, or caused by, any other hardware or software (for example, the Arduino™ software) used with the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board;
- Any failures caused by neglect, misuse (for instance, use in contravention to the user manual or the technical specifications or use of the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board in or near water), or modification of the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board;
- Any responsibility for regulatory compliance (for example, compliance with CE markings in Europe) of the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board when it is combined with other products or software. This is your responsibility, because we don't know what you will make of the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board;
- Any use in applications which are in or related to the following fields: aerospace, medical, military, nuclear or any other mission-critical or safety-critical fields;
- Any damage caused by using the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board without a power supply, or with the wrong power supply; and
- Any consequence resulting from accident, earthquake, fire, or other external cause outside of Intel's control.

**What is the practical effect of the Intel One Year Limited Warranty?** If during the 1 year from the original date of purchase of the new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board the board fails to perform in accordance with the limited warranty, you should contact Intel at [www.intel.com/support/go/Galileo](http://www.intel.com/support/go/Galileo) where you will find the step-by-step process to handle your return. Once we verify that you are entitled to take advantage of the warranty process, Intel may in its sole discretion and option: (i) **repair** the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board, which will extend the *original* warranty period by an additional 90 days; or (ii) **replace** the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board, wherein the original warranty period will apply; or (iii) **refund** to you your documented costs of purchasing the failed Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board.

**Please note that you may choose not to take advantage of these extra Intel warranty rights. You may choose to use your other rights against whomever sold you the Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board. The Intel limited warranty rights in this document are in addition to (and not instead of) your contractual rights and your consumer law and consumer protection rights.**

#### **DISCLAIMERS AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY**

**Under the Intel One Year Limited Warranty, Intel will never be liable for:**

- (i) any loss or damage that was not caused by Intel's breach of the Intel One Year Limited Warranty;
- (ii) any loss or damage that was not reasonably foreseeable when you purchased the new Intel® Galileo Gen 2 board. The sort of thing Intel is not responsible for includes (but is not limited to) loss or damage which is lost profits, loss of opportunity or loss of data.

**If Intel is responsible under the Intel One Year Limited Warranty (or otherwise under consumer protection law or due to Intel's negligence in manufacture or distribution) Intel will always accept liability, without limitation, for claims for death or personal injury or damage to private property. Intel will also always be responsible for any fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation by Intel.**

**IMPORTANT: You may also have other rights (statutory rights) in addition to this warranty and your statutory rights may vary from state to state or from country to country.** We recommend that you consult your local trading standards offices, consumer association or citizens' advice bureau to understand your rights as a consumer.
