¹ Some historical figures have been restated. The majority reflect minor changes that occur when new information is received after the close of the data collection period. For example, some injuries are reported after the close of the year, resulting in adjustments in the health and safety figures. Additionally, the Dalian, China site was sold subsequent to year-end 2021 as part of the first closing of the divestiture of our NAND Memory business. Therefore, Dalian is not included in our sustainability goals and metrics beginning in 2022, and has been removed from the GHG inventory for all years. Values can differ from those reported in the Corporate Responsibility Report due to rounding.

² CO₂e = Carbon dioxide equivalent. Scope 2 emissions are based on The GHG Protocol, Market-Based Methodology.

³ Other direct GHG emissions includes emissions from heat transfer fluids, volatile organic compounds (VOCs), leased assets, refrigerant leaks, and onsite vehicle use.
