



How to generate a Temporary License?

This document serves as a guide to generate temporary licenses from the Self-Service Licensing Center.

For a multiple-user license, if a user need access to the license when not connected to the floating server, user can generate a two-week temporary license. Do ensure that the computer has product(s) before generating temporary license.

Step 1	:	Log on to the Intel Self Service Licensing Center. Navigation: https://fpgasupport.intel.com/Licensing/license/index.html
Step 2	:	Enter your username and password
Step 3	:	Click the Self-Service Licensing Center link
Step 4	:	Select Computers and License Files tab
Step 5	:	Click Generate Companion / Temporary Licenses button
Step 6	:	Select the computer with FLOAT license type to generate temporary license and click Next button.
Step 7	:	Enter the Temporary computer NIC ID
Step 8	:	Click Get License button



How to generate a Companion License?

For a single-user license, if the same user needs to use the license on multiple computers, you can add up to two companion IDs for the license to work on additional computers.

Step 1	:	Log on to the Intel Self Service Licensing Center. Navigation: https://fpgasupport.intel.com/Licensing/license/index.html
Step 2	:	Enter your username and password
Step 3	:	Click the Self-Service Licensing Center link
Step 4	:	Select Computers and License Files tab
Step 5	:	Click Generate Companion / Temporary Licenses button
Step 6	:	Select the computer with or without companion ID(s).
Step 7	:	If the computer does not have any companion ID(s), enter the companion ID(s).
Step 8	:	Click Get License button.
