Guidelines when filling the End User Certificate, or “EUC”, Form

Following these instructions will complete the EUC process, prevent additional requests to the customer for missing or incorrect EUC, and avoid delay and disruption to the customer relationship.

EUC document

- Company letterhead is required.
- Company stamp is not required.
- Intel will accept a scanned electronic copy with a valid signature (see below).
- Mailing an original signed paper copy to Intel is not required.
- Do not revise Intel wording in the EUC.
 - The customer may indicate their requested changes and send it to Intel for our review and approval prior to signature.

Information in the EUC

- English is required.
- Company legal address is required.
 - Include the address(es) of locations the customer may ship to or the location of the entities engaging with Intel in any other trade or financial transaction.
 - If there is more than one location, list addresses at the end of the form (page 2).
 - This includes any subsidiaries, domestic/in-country sites.
 - Addresses not listed on the form are not covered by the EUC may cause additional requests to the customer
- Notify Intel of any changes to the information in a signed EUC at export.customer@intel.com

Signature and EUC duration

- Signing parties must have signatory authority for their company.
 - Preference is to someone from Legal or Trade Compliance for that company.
- EUC expire 2 years after date of customer signature.
- Intel may request the customer complete a revised Intel EUC form at any time.

End User Certification (EUC)

Intel Products may be subject to export controls under the laws and regulations of the United States and other applicable governments as required. Intel Products include without limitation hardware, software, technical data, servicing, support and training.

Without prior authorization from the U.S. Government and/or other applicable governments as required we certify:

- Not to export/re-export/transfer/sell/resell Intel Products, to customers who intend to purchase or transfer Intel Products for end-use in any country or destination subject to comprehensive export controls or economic sanctions (Embargoed Country), which currently include Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan, Syria and Crimea.
- Not to export/re-export/transfer/sell/resell Intel Products to any party not eligible to receive them, or purchase Intel products on behalf of such parties. (For example, persons listed on the Denied Persons List, Entity List, Specially Designated Nationals List, Sectoral Sanctions Identifications List, or similar lists maintained by governments with jurisdiction)
- Not to export/re-export/transfer/sell/resell Intel Products if they will be or are intended to be used for a military end-use or by a military end-user of the following countries listed in the Export Administration Regulations (EAR) D1 or D5 country list: Afghanistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Burma, Cambodia, Central African Republic, China, Cuba, Cyprus, Democratic Republic of Congo, Eritrea, Georgia, Haiti, Iran, Iraq, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Lebanon, Libya, Macau, Moldova, Mongolia, North Korea, Russia, Somalia, Sudan, South Sudan, Syria, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Venezuela, Vietnam, or Zimbabwe.
- Not to process or incorporate Intel Products and technology into secondary products, including supercomputers, which contribute to the design, development, manufacture, production, testing, stockpiling or use of any nuclear, chemical, or biological weapons.
- That Intel Products are not intended for use in, support of: exploration or production for deepwater, Arctic offshore, or shale projects that have the potential to produce oil or gas, (a) in which a Russian energy firm is involved, or (b) which is located in the Russian Federation or (c) in a maritime area claimed by the Russian Federation.

We also certify:

- That we are not a party designated under U.S or EU Sanctions, except for U.S. Sectoral Sanctions that restrict the provision of new debt or equity beyond a specific length of time.
- That we are neither owned nor controlled by a designated party under U.S or EU Sanctions.
- That the answers we have provided remain applicable and extend to any order or purchase-where we request Intel to export the Product directly to another organization on our behalf.
- That we will notify Intel of any changes to these responses. (export.customer@intel.com).
