

## SUPPLIER TECHNOLOGY CONTROL QUESTIONNAIRE FOR CONTINGENT WORKER (CW) & PRIVILEGED VISITOR (PV)

Intel works in technology areas that are subject to export controls by the United States government. Intel must obtain authorization from the Bureau of Industry and Security, U.S. Department of Commerce, before permitting access to citizens from certain countries to Intel technology. This questionnaire is designed to assist Intel in determining whether an export license is required for the potential new CW or PV.

**Information on Questions:** The Bureau of Industry and Security, U.S. Department of Commerce requires U.S. companies to make export license determinations based on the candidate's last country of affiliation. Intel is requesting legal status information regarding a person's legal status in the country where the work will occur to determine whether or not the CW or PV requires an approved export license or if an \*intra-company export license can be used.

\*Intra-company export licenses are approved for certain sites located outside the U.S. with Conditions.

Generally, an export analysis is required for every CW or PV except those whose work for Intel will take place in a country where the CW/PV is a citizen, national, landed immigrant or legal permanent resident, or otherwise has the unlimited right to live and work based on the laws of the host country where the person will work.

Special instruction for persons with **Dual Citizenship**: Export rules regard you as a citizen of the country where you last (most recently) obtained citizenship. Answer the questions below as though you were only a citizen of the country were you last obtained citizenship.

Question #1: $\square$ Yes / No $\square$ As of today is the CW or PV any of the following (1a-1d):		
1a.	Citizen or National of the country where the work takes place?	
1b.	Lawful Permanent Resident or Landed Immigrant of the country in which the work takes place? (Only having an application for permanent resident status or landed immigrant status pending requires a NO answer.) (NOTE: In the U.S. Lawful Permanent Resident refers to a U.S. Legal Permanent Resident or "Green Card" holder. Outside of the U.S., Lawful Permanent Resident or Landed Immigrant refers to someone who has the legal right to live and work indefinitely in the country where the work takes place.)	
1c.	A person granted refugee status in the country in which the work will take place? (This is not applicable to persons in the U.S. <b>granted</b> public interest parole or humanitarian parole status. Refugee refers to someone granted the legal right to live and work in the country where the work will occur based on a well founded fear of persecution on account of race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion.)	



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A person granted political asylum status of the country in which the work takes place? (Note that only having an asylum application pending requires a NO answer. Political asylum status refers to someone granted the legal right to live and work in the country where the work will occur based on a well founded fear of persecution on account of race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion.)

If the CW or PV answered "Yes" to any of the legal status categories mentioned above in Question #1, do not complete Questions #2 and 3.

**Question #2:** If CW or PV answered **"No"** to all of the legal status categories mentioned in Question #1, what is the issuing country of the CW's or PV's **most current** passport?

**Question #3:** If CW or PV has permanent resident status or landed immigrant status in another country, please identify the country where the CW or PW has permanent resident status or landed immigrant status. (See question 1B for the definition of permanent resident status or landed immigrant status.)

**CERTIFICATION**: I understand that any work assignment at Intel may be conditional upon export license requirements and approval by the Bureau of Industry and Security, U.S. Department of Commerce (www.bis.doc.gov).

To the extent permitted by applicable law or regulations, by signing this document I agree that this document and the personal information contained in it may be retained by Intel and may be accessed by any authorized personnel within Intel's Security and/or Legal team and/or Export Control team.

I also agree that this document and the personal information contained in it may be provided to government agencies upon request and to any other third party as may be required by law.

This document will be kept for up to 7 years, or as long as required in order to run the day-to-day business and to comply with various local, state and national laws. This document is **only** intended to meet Intel export compliance requirements.
