**Reminder: Updated Wellness Self-Screenings Required for On-site Workers and Entrance Pilot Introduction**

Following the issuance of the State of Arizona's [Enhanced COVID-19 Action Plan](#) and the [City of Chandler's June 19 proclamation](#), we would like to remind those of you working on-site that you should be conducting a self-screening for symptoms - including a temperature check - in your home or another private location before coming to work each day.

Please do not come to work if you have any one or more of these symptoms, which is new or not explained by another reason:

- Fever ( $\geq 100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$  /  $38^{\circ}\text{C}$ )
- Coughing
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Muscle soreness
- Chills
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Instead, notify your manager via phone that you are ill. If you think your illness is related to the coronavirus, contact your employer and consult your health care provider.

**Chandler & Ocotillo Wellness Certification Pilot Starting July 3**  
***Entrances to Require Verbal or Digital Health Check Confirmation***

Corporate Services is partnering with Intel IT to pilot a new wellness certification procedure for on-site workers at our Chandler & Ocotillo campuses. Starting July 3 at the CH-5/6, CH-2, and CH-7 lobby, OC-2, OC-6, OC-8, and FSB Turnstile entrances, you will need to certify that you have completed your self-screening for symptoms. You may notice teams setting up screening areas in front of these entrances, and we plan to expand this process to other entrances in the coming weeks.

## Get the Mobile Survey

## How the certification works

Each time you enter the workplace through one of these entrances, you will be asked to certify your wellness with a member of our screening team. There are two ways to do so:

- **Mobile survey:** Display the results of a health declaration survey taken on your mobile smartphone. Based on your response, you will receive confirmation that you can enter.
- **Verbal confirmation:** If you do not have a smartphone or would prefer not to use the mobile survey, you may verbally confirm you have completed your self-screening (symptoms listed above).

If your responses to the mobile survey or verbal confirmation do not meet Intel's requirements, you will be asked to leave the screening area and provided a handout with next steps.

## Protecting your privacy

Your personal information, including mobile survey responses and verbal confirmations, will not be recorded. If you would like to complete this certification in a private location, please use the CH-5/6 (Chandler Campus) or OC-8 (Ocotillo Campus) lobby entrance.

## Take your belongings each time you leave

Each time you leave the workplace, please bring all your personal belongings with you. In the event that you do not meet the wellness requirements upon return, you will not be permitted to reenter the facility.

## Staying safe on-site

While on-site, please continue to wear your facemask or face covering and observe our social distancing and other safety practices. Social distancing and frequent, thorough hand washing are still the most effective ways to prevent the spread of the virus. If you observe someone who is not following this policy or any other safety protocol, we encourage you to respectfully remind them of our requirements.
