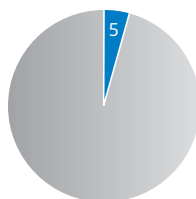

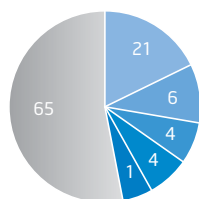

37% of dollars



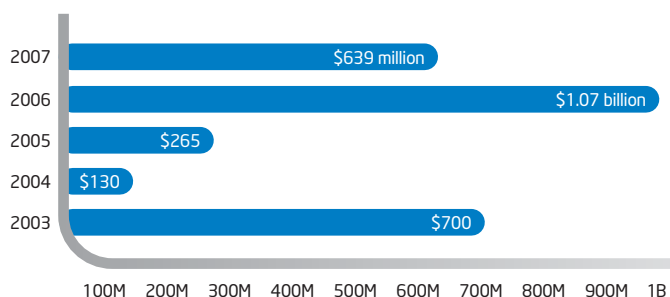
